2. By using positive coaching methods, I can make the experience enjoyable for my players, increase their self-esteem, and inspire a true sense of enjoyment for the sport they are playing.
3. I will treat officials with dignity and respect, and I will instruct the players and their parents to do likewise.
4. It is my pledge to treat opposing coaches and players with respect and dignity, and to encourage players and their parents to do the same.
5. No matter what the outcome of the game is, I will demonstrate grace, dignity, and composure.
6. All player participation rules will be observed, and I will strive to make each player feel valued regardless of their physical or developmental limitations.
7. Players will learn the principles of fair play and sportsmanship, and I will model these principles all the time.
8. It is my goal to learn the rules of the game and to teach those rules to players and their parents.
9. I will always encourage safe play and will inform UVYSL of any unsafe conditions as soon as possible.
10. I will not engage in any manner of personal abuse and harassment of others.
